Rules and Regulations:

Rule 1 Weigh-in begins Monday, June 23, 2008, from 8 a.m. to noon and 2 to 6 p.m. No pigs may arrive on the fairgrounds before 6 a.m., Monday, June 23, 2008. All hogs must be removed from the fairgrounds by 5 p.m., Thursday, June 26. Weights will be 215 - 275 lbs. for gilts and/or barrows. Pigs disqualified for weight may be substituted.

Rule 2 *Entries allowed per exhibitor - two single barrows, one pair of barrows and one breeding gilt, two single market gilts and a pair of market gilts.*

Rule 3 When coming to the fair, all swine should enter the northeast gate of the fairgrounds. Health certificates must accompany all swine, may be inspected. **Health papers must be turned in to the superintendent at weigh-in.**

Rule 4 All exhibitors must be 8 years old as of September 1, 2007 and under 19 years of age as of September 1, 2007.

Rule 5 Only junior exhibitors will be allowed to show. Any and all conflicts must be cleared through the swine superintendent. All animals must be owned by the exhibitor. Junior exhibitors may exhibit their 4-H sale barrow.

Rule 6 Barrow and market gilt classes will be divided by weight after all animals are weighed in.

Rule 7 Livestock tie-outs, trucks, trailers, etc., must park in the **North Lot** or exhibitor will forfeit premiums. **PLEASE - do not park cars in this area!**

Rule 8 Due to the high cost of postage, all premium checks are to be picked up in the Secretary's Office before the exhibitor leaves the fairgrounds. **A social security number is required for the release of checks.** If the check is *not* picked up, the exhibitor will forfeit their premium check to the Fair Association. If you would like your check mailed to you, please bring a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Secretary's Office (or purchase in the office) by 8 p.m. the last day of fair.

Rule 9 Single gilts must be entered as a Market Gilt to show as a pair of Market Gilts entry.

NO HOGS WILL BE SOLD AT THE FAIR AS A GROUP OR INDIVIDUALLY

Premiums: 1st - \$30, 2nd - \$24, 3rd - \$18, 4th - \$15, 5th - \$12, 6th - \$10, 7th - \$9, 8th - \$8, 9th - \$7, 10th - \$6.
