All pulls can be in first or second gear.

## **FARM STOCK TRACTOR PULL RULES:**

### **10000 - 12,000 - 14,500 LBS**

#### **3000 RPM LIMIT - will check prior to pull and after if questionable!**

1. Factory stock or OEM replacement block, OEM style injection pump for that make and model tractor. Tractor may have 1 turbo and must be OEM style TO4, 3LM or equivalent style.. NOTHING else will be allowed.
2. Engine must run on fuel it was designed to from the factory, no water or alcohol injection.
3. Tire size limited to 20.8 x 38 or 18.4 x 42, no cut or sharpened tires allowed. Pressed steel disk wheels allowed.
4. Weight must be secured safely, not to extend more than 18 inches in front of tractor, also rear weights must allow for safe hookup of sled to tractor drawbar.
5. Drawbar height maximum of 20 inches and must be at least 18 inches from center of axle. Tractor must furnish own clevis and it must be safely secured to the tractor. Judges and officials will check this. This is for your own and everyone's safety.
6. If tractor goes out of bounds the pull will be disqualified.
7. Tractor must have working PTO, working hydraulics and 3pt hitch. Rockshaft must be in place.
8. Tractor may enter 2 classes but may enter the same class only once.
9. First puller of class will have option of taking the pull or coming back third or last. If it is decided to reset the sled after a couple of pulls, the puller up at the time will be come the first puller of the class.
10. Puller has two chances to get the sled moving, if the puller shuts down or makes a good attempt to shut down (by judges or official ruling) by 75 foot flag he/ she has the option to come right back or drop to the last hook.
11. Disobeying the flagmen, hook men, sled operator, judges or other official or arguing with any of them will be grounds for disqualification.

### **7500 & 8500 Naturally aspirated**

1. Tire size limit is 18.4 x 38, no cut or sharpened tires allowed. No pressed steel wheels unless they are a factory option.
2. Weight must be secured safely, not to extend more than 18 inches in front of tractor, also rear weights must allow for safe hookup of sled to tractor drawbar.
3. Drawbar height maximum of 20 inches and must be at least 18 inches from center of axle. Tractor must furnish own clevis and it must be safely secured to the tractor. Judges and officials will check this. This is for your own and everyone's safety.
4. Tractor may enter 2 classes bu may enter the same class only once.

**Drivers between 14-18 years of age must have written consent of parent/  
guardian for each pull and all classes.**
