Rules and Regulations --Please call superintendent with any questions.

DRIVERS

1. MUST be 18 years of age, 16 & 17 year olds need notarized permit with parent's consent and signature.

Any driver using an open face helmet will NOT be covered by insurance if facial injury occurs.

One person per car and MUST attend the meeting before the race.

4. Drivers will NOT drink beer or liquor before or during race.

5. MUST wear approved racing helmets and seat belts.

CAR PREPARATION:

Any car 80 and newer

All cars must be stock, unless modification is stated in the rules.

All glass, plastic, chrome, and interior must be removed from car.

All decking in station wagons MUST be removed!!!

Tires no bigger than 15 inch, No split rim. Valve stem protectors OK.

Use motor and tranny of choice, motor must be in stock location. You may chain or weld motor and tranny to keep in place (don't strengthen the frame).

Use rear end of choice, must be 5 lug. You can tilt rear end if you wish. Welded or posi-track highly recommended. You may chain rear end in 4 spots.

Radiator must be in stock location.

All cars must have working brakes.

All trailer hitches must be removed.

Original gas tanks must be removed. You must use a boat tank or well made fuel cell and it must be properly secured and covered. Plastic gas tanks must be covered with a metal shield!

Batteries must be moved to passenger floorboard and properly secured.

Hoods must have 2 to 4 inch holes for fires.

CAR BUILDING:

Doors, tailgates, trunks may be wired, chained or welded with no more than a 5-inch wide strap ¼-inch thick.

Bumpers are interchangeable. Any automotive bumper and bumper brackets may be used on an car. Make sure bumper is welded solid.

Trunks may have 8 bolts in them.

Hood may have 8 bolts total. May have 5" washer on sheet metal only to hold bolts.

Frame welding: Top seams only, from cross member forward, no added metal

****For driver's protection, you may weld a bar behind the seat at rear of back door, and also a bar across the dash. You may connect these bars with 2 cross bars. Roll bars allowed. Roll over bar may be welded to the frame. May run 4 bars from cage to frame. Must connect to flat part of frame under the cage.**

Body bolts may be changed, you may use up to 1-inch bolts. You may also add 4 additional body mounts.

Washers cannot exceed over 5-inch.

Suspension: No Leaf Spring conversion

Fenders may be cut out. Fenders may be bolted back together or welded.

Must have at least 1 bar in windshield from roof to dash for safety reasons.

Unlimited wire allowed.

All hoods must be open for inspection.

RACING:

1. Two fires in your car disqualifies you.

NO hitting drivers door, NO deliberate head on crashes - AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION!

3. Drivers of cars laying back, hiding or playing possum will be DISQUALIFIED!

4. Remain in the car with helmet and eye protection on until completion of the race, unless otherwise instructed.

5. Prizes will be awarded ONLY after passing post-race inspection!!

PIT AREA & INSPECTIONS

1. NO one will be permitted in pits without a pit pass.

2. NO alcoholic beverages or drugs are permitted in the pit area. **If alcohol or drugs are found in the your pit area you will be disqualified and asked to leave the grounds with no refund.**

3. No pit persons allowed in arena or track, any violation will result in disqualification.

4. Management DOES have the right to inspect or disqualify a car and or driver at ANY TIME!

Any cars not removed from the grounds by noon the next day become property of Henry County Fair.
