RULES AND REGULATIONS:

RULE 1: Open and Junior show sheep must be in place by 9:00 PM, Monday, June 21, 2010.

RULE 2: Only two premiums allowed per exhibitor per class.

RULE 3: We reserve the right to limit pens.

RULE 4: All livestock tie-outs, trucks, trailers, etc., must park in designated livestock areas or forfeit exhibitors premiums.

RULE 5: **NO MUZZLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY SHEEP.** The Illinois Humane Care for Animals Act prohibits physical mistreatment of animals. The use of electric shock OR manual striking of sheep, OR withholding feed and water are considered direct violations of this Act. The presence of any type of equipment to induce electrical shock in the exhibition area will be considered as intent to inflict electrical shock on animals under care of the person with the equipment. Persons found mistreating sheep shall be prohibited from exhibiting and be dismissed from the fair grounds.

RULE 6: All animals entered must be registered in their respective breed association in the exhibitor's name. Exhibitors must be prepared to show certificates of registration upon request of the superintendent. No Grades.

RULE 7: Should a question of age or breed arise, the Superintendent reserves the right to disqualify the entry.

RULE 8: All Sheep must have an identification ear tag or tattoo number as well as their scrapie ID tag to exhibit.

RULE 9: All sheep entered in open or junior show will have pens assigned by the open sheep superintendent. No free 4-H pens until after the open and junior shows are released Wednesday afternoon.

RULE 10: Any ewe lambs shown in any of the breeding classes ARE NOT eligible for any of the market lamb classes.

RULE 11: Release time – Open Breeding Sheep – after the show Tuesday. (Due to the high cost of postage, all premium checks are to be picked up in the Secretary's office before the exhibitor leaves the fairgrounds. If the check is not picked up, the exhibitor will forfeit their premium check to the Fair Association.) If you would like the check mailed to you, please bring a self-addressed stamped envelope to the Secretary's Office.

RULE: 12 All sheep must be properly fitted for their breed. If not superintendent or judge can deny them from being showed and entry fees will be forfeited.

RULE: 13 If **Only one** breeder showing in a breed that breed will be **combined** with All other Breed (AOV).

Flock ----- 1Ram Yr. or Lamb, 1 Yr. Ewe, 1 Ewe Lamb
