**\*Swine Exhibition Health Rules For 2010--** Health Regulations WILL be enforced! \* All animals must be ear notched or ear tagged so they are individually identifiable.

1. **For Non-Quarantined Swine Farms/Individuals** --Health certificates must show that barrows and gilts of all ages are negative to an official test for pseudorabies conducted within 90 days prior to exhibition, or that the swine originated from a qualified pseudorabies negative herd. The qualified pseudorabies negative herd number and date of last qualification test must be shown on the health certificate.
2. **Quarantined herds/farms/individuals** --Swine from pseudorabies (PRY) quarantined herds are NOT allowed to exhibit regardless of whether or not the show is terminal or non-terminal.
3. **All Swine** must be accompanied by a health certificate issued within 90 days prior to exhibition.

**RULES & REGULATIONS:**

- Rule 1 Weigh-in for all swine will be Monday, June 21, 2010 from 8 a.m. to noon and 2- 6 p.m. No pigs may arrive on the fairgrounds before 6 a.m. Monday, June 21, 2010. Swine may leave the fairgrounds after the open sho or Jr. Show. All other hogs must be off the fairgrounds by 10 am Friday, June 25, 2010
- Rule 2 When coming to the fair, all swine should enter the northeast gate of the fairgrounds. Health certificates must accompany all swine. The papers may be inspected by a State Veterinary Office Official.
- Rule 3 Barrows and gilts will not exhibit against each other in any classes.
- Rule 4 Single gilts must be entered as a market gilt to show as a pair of market gilts entry.
- Rule 5 Classes will be divided by weight according to number of entries.
- Rule 6 Barrows and market gilts must weigh between 200 - 275 lbs. (hogs will be weighed only once).
- Rule 7 Health papers must be turned in to the superintendent during weigh-in.
- Rule 8 Any pigs not meeting stated weights WILL NOT have the opportunity to show in ANY class (except showmanship). Additional pigs may be brought as substitute entries for those disqualified by weight and must meet the same health requirements.
- Rule 9 All livestock tie-outs and trucks, trailers, etc., must park in the North lot or you forfeit your premiums.
- Rule 10 Entries: 6 single barrows per person, 3 pairs of barrows per person, 3 Gilts per person.
- Rule 11 4-H and Junior Barrows are eligible for the Open Barrow Show if proper entry fees are paid.
- Rule 12 Barrows shown in Tuesday's Open Show only will be released immediately after the show. **Each exhibitor is responsible for the removal of their animals from the fairgrounds!**
- Rule 13 **Due to the high cost of postage, all premium checks are to be picked up in the Secretary's Office before the exhibitor leaves the fairgrounds. If the check is not picked up, the exhibitor will forfeit their premium check to the Fair Association. A social security number is required for the release of the check.** If carcass results (for the Open Carcass Special) aren't in before the last day of the fair, those checks will be mailed. If you would like your check mailed to you, please bring a self-addressed, stamped envelope to the Secretary's Office by 8 p.m. Sunday, the last day of fair.
